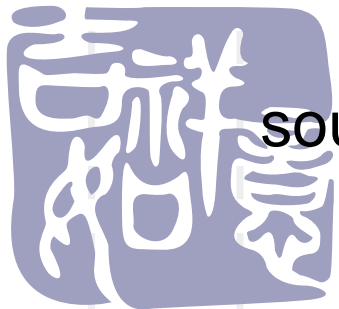

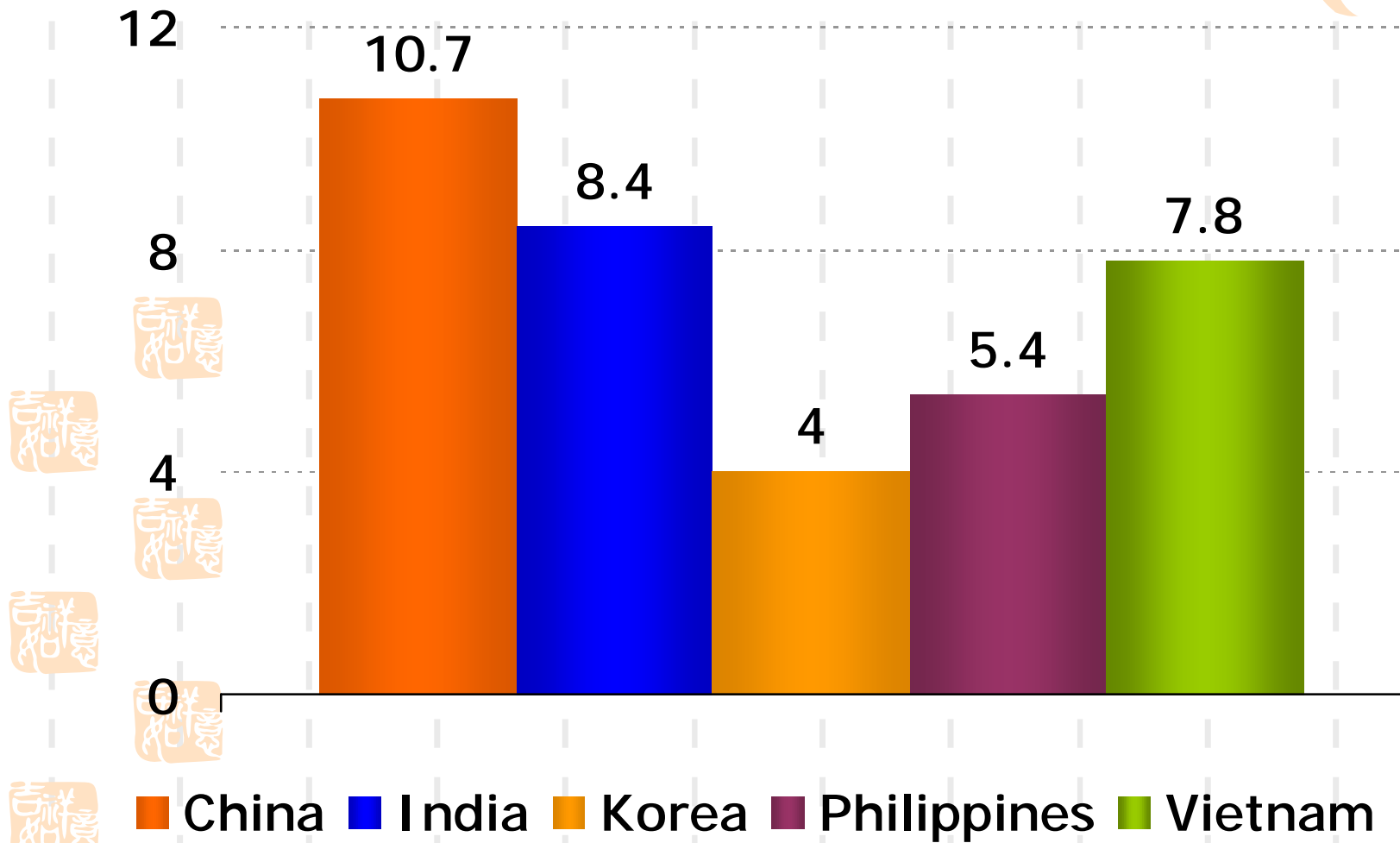

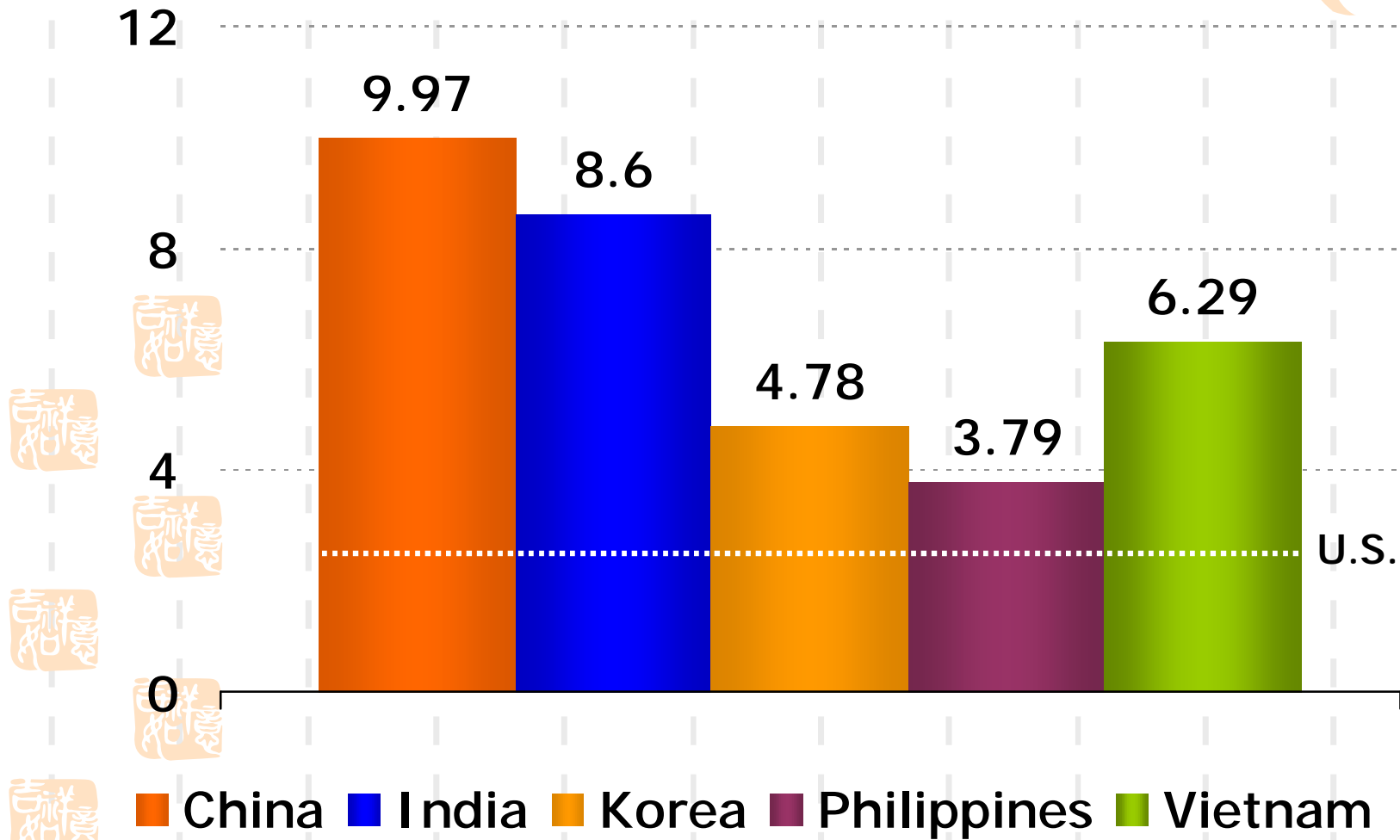
Average GDP Growth

Projected GDP Growth

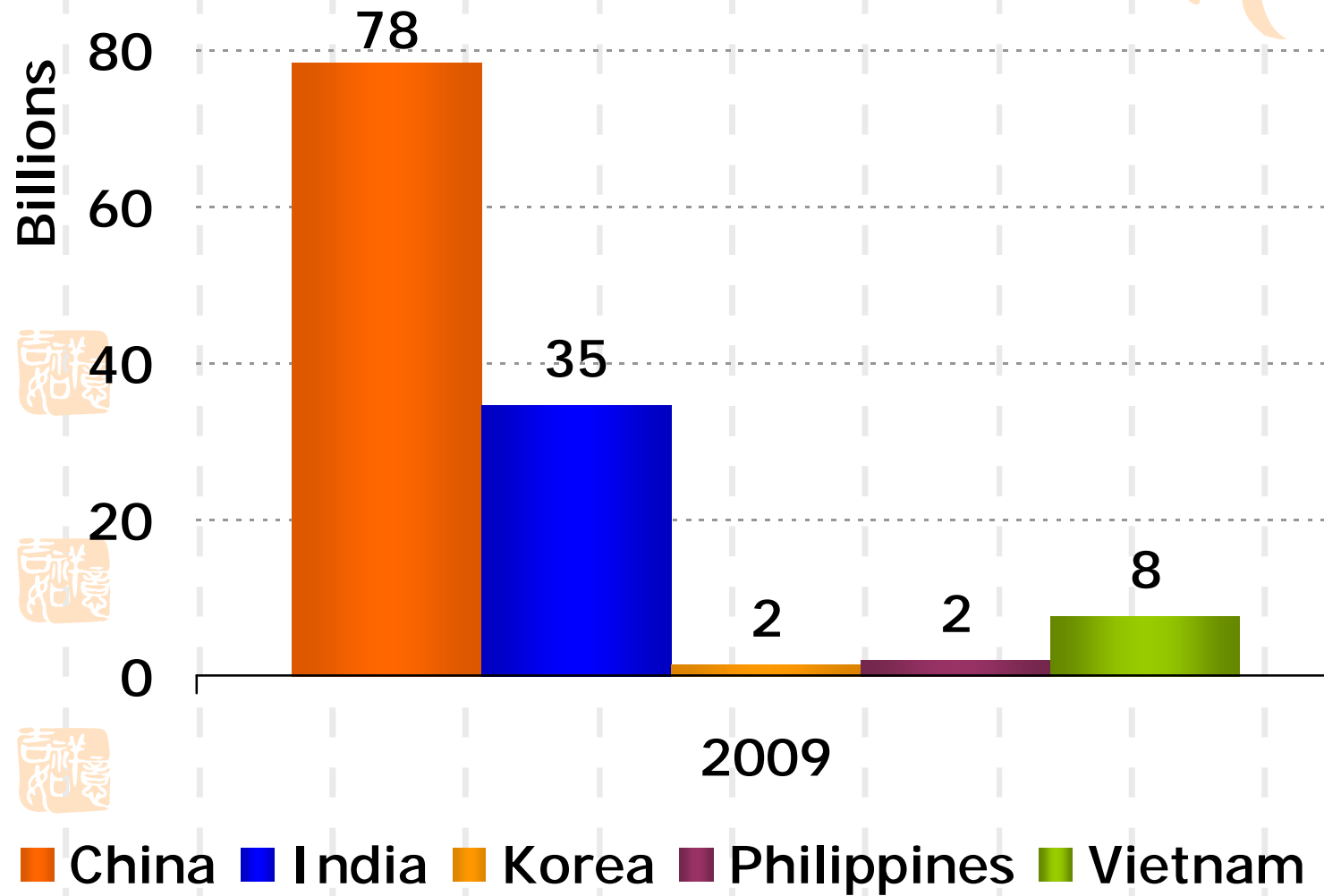

Foreign Direct Investments

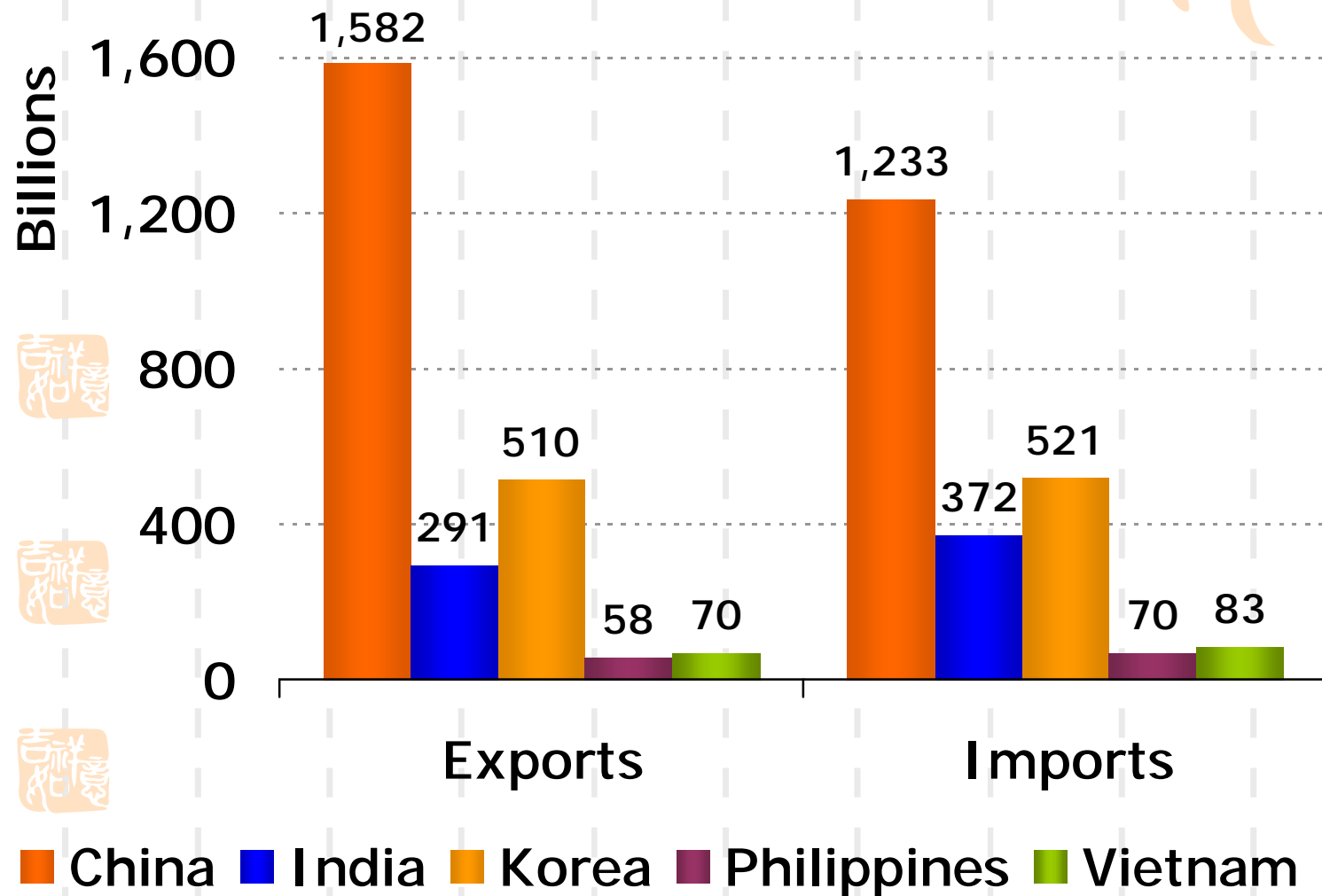

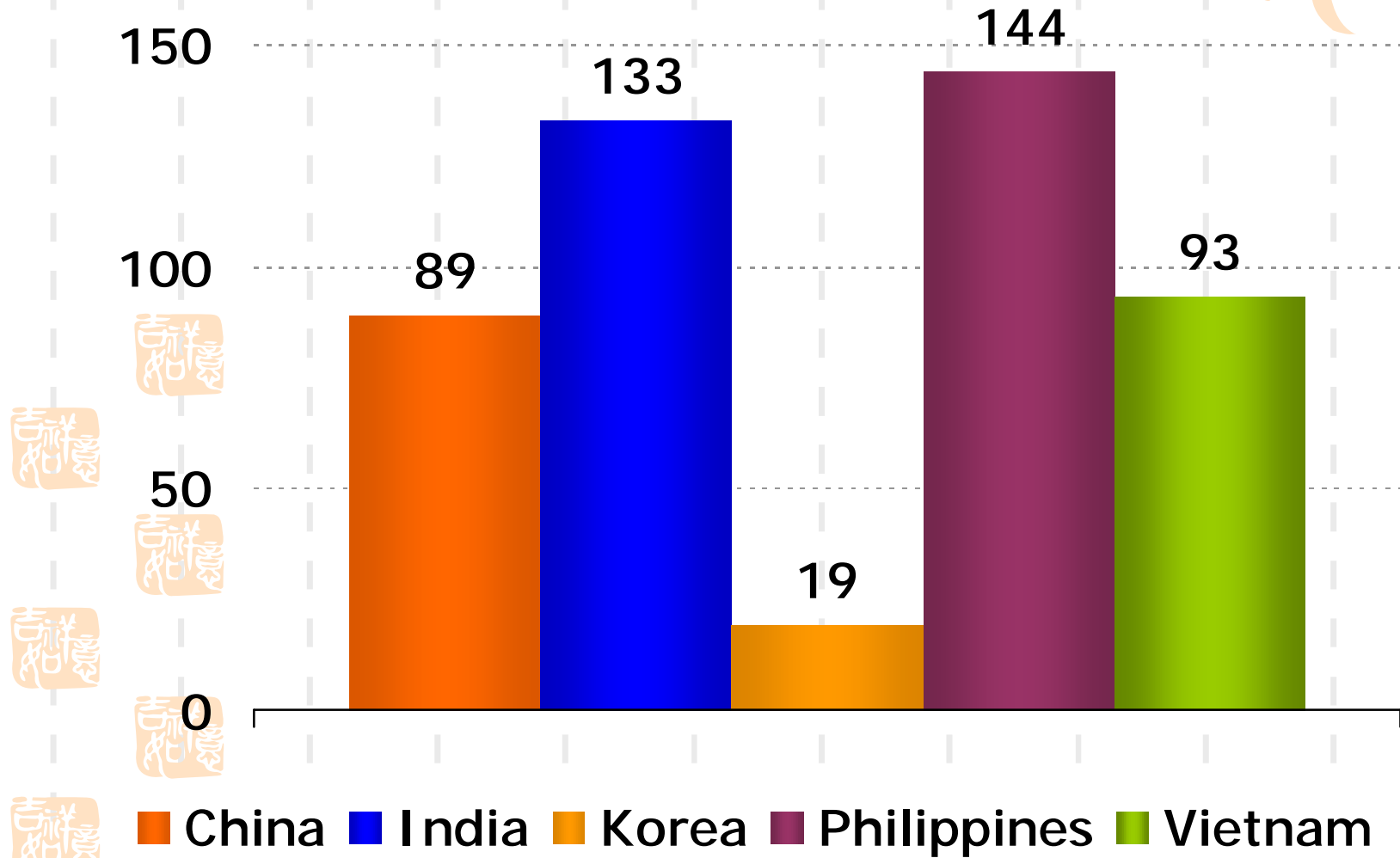
