



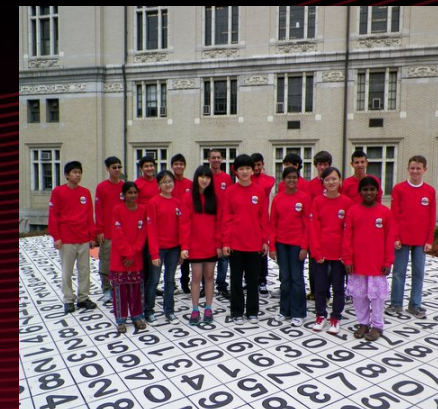
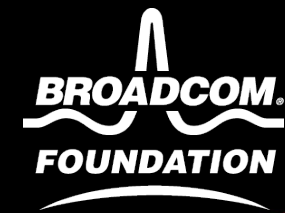

BY 2020, THE NUMBER OF CONNECTED DEVICES IS EXPECTED TO REACH 50 BILLION

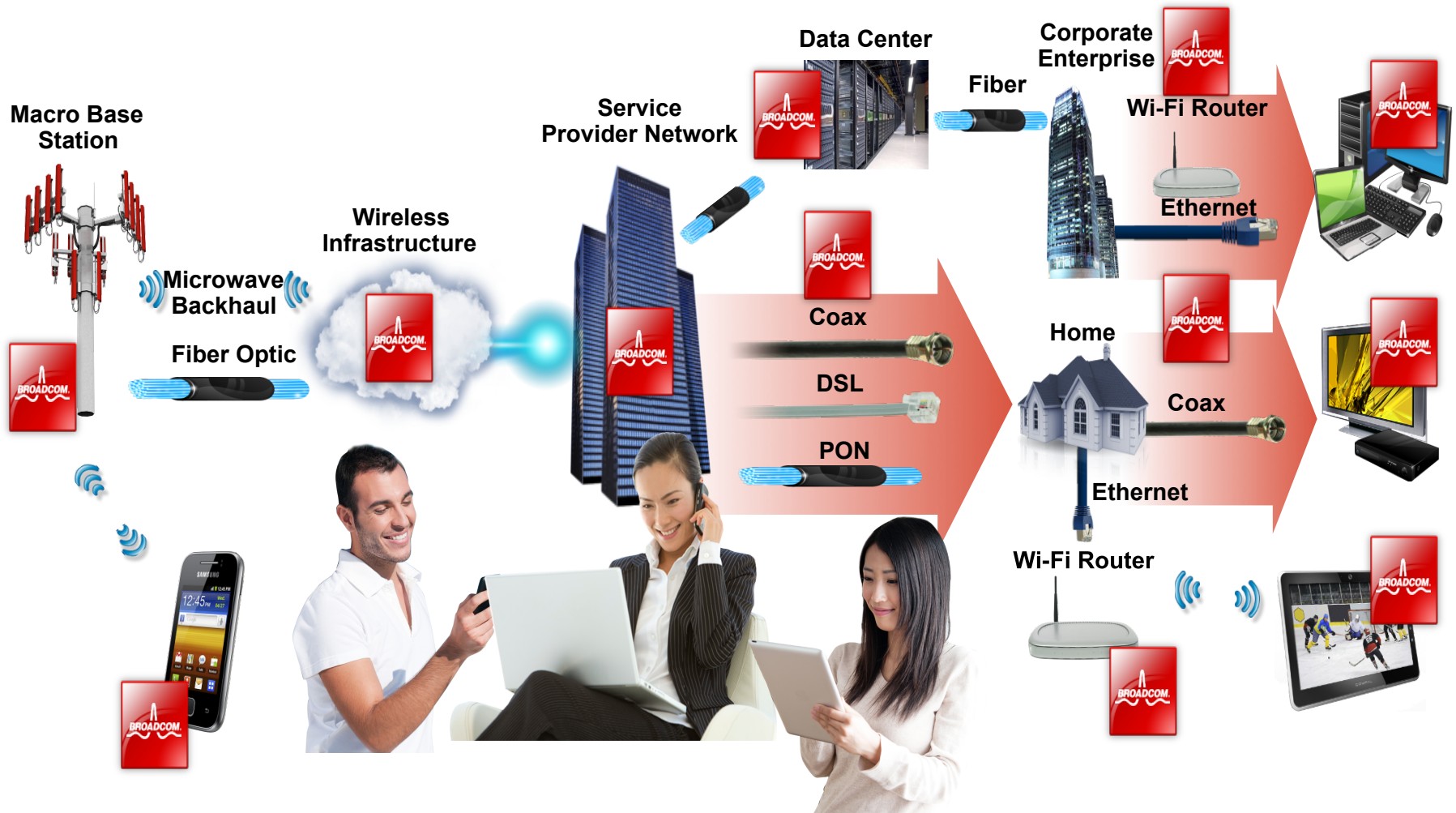

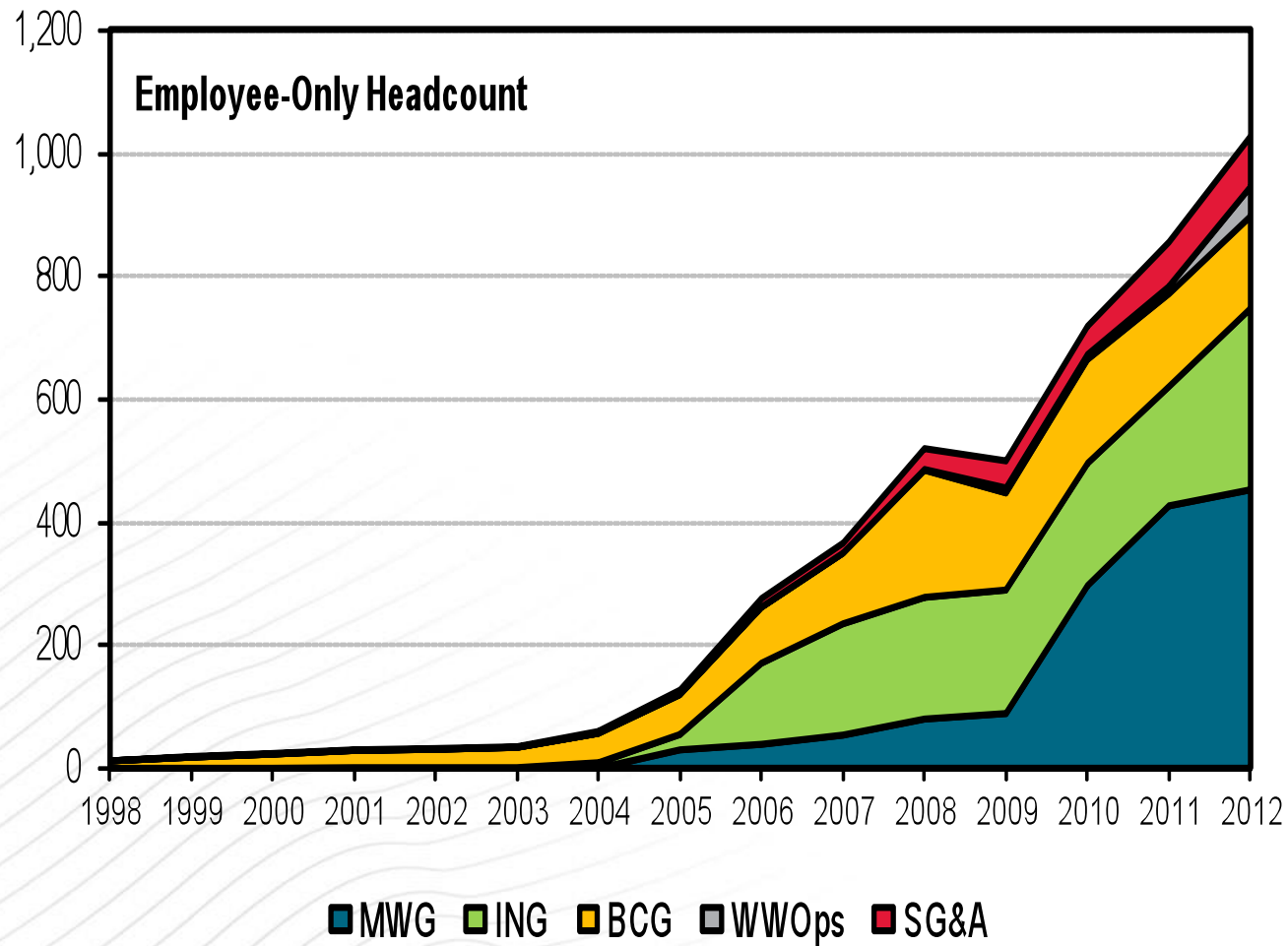

- The experience of creating a science or engineering project based on a personal passion and presenting the project at a MASTERS science fair can inspire a student to continue with math and science courses throughout high school in order to pursue a career based on this passion.

- Affiliated science fairs take place at regional, state and national levels throughout the year; the US Broadcom MASTERS is held in the fall and the International MASTERS takes place in the spring.

- MASTERS Delegates are awarded a trip to the most prestigious International Science Fair with over 1600 participants from all over the world

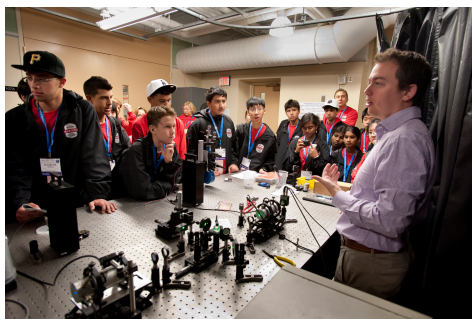

BROADCOM MASTERS INDIA - HIGHLIGHTS



BANGALORE: PROJECT LOTUS



- **Broadcom Foundation helps leverage Project LOTUS, the robust volunteer program of the Broadcom Bangalore office through support to San Francisco-based NGO Sikshana – ‘Help Them Grow’. Launched in 2002, Project LOTUS provides educational and social improvement to over 600 students at four inner-city and three rural underprivileged schools; serving five elementary and two middle schools.**
- **2011 LOTUS activities included:**
 - **Scholarships: LOTUS scholarship program supports more than 50 students, grades 6-12 through local contributions. LOTUS also helped administer the ASER test in July.**
 - **Science Experimentation: LOTUS sponsored Shivappa, a well-known free lance science experiment enthusiast, to conduct interactive Science Experiments and basic Math sessions in July. LOTUS organized a ‘Science Experiments Day’ with science kits to introduce students to project-based learning.**
 - **Art Competition: LOTUS organized a drawing and painting competition for all students of the inner-city schools in August.**
 - **Cultural Exposure: LOTUS subsidizes the Fun Trip for Kids for the four inner-city schools to nearby tourist & pilgrimage sites.**

HYDERABAD: RED CROSS FLOOD RELIEF



- **Broadcom's India Technologies Pvt Ltd in Hyderabad was awarded a Gold medal by His Excellency, the Governor of Andhra Pradesh for helping the Red Cross mobilize resources for humanitarian activities for the financial year of 2008-2009.**
- **The entire Broadcom team demonstrated their compassionate response to the 2008 Bihar flood when the river changed its course and inundated areas that had not experienced floods in many decades, impacting over 2.3 million people.**
- **200 employees contributed a one day of their salaries to the International Red Cross Foundation for Bihar flood relief. They also participated in relief efforts at blood donation camps.**
- **The team at Technologies Pvt Ltd in Hyderabad has been volunteering with their community for the last 5 years; the Gold Medal recognized their work with the Red Cross and their dedication to the community.**
